A Message to the FGLI Community

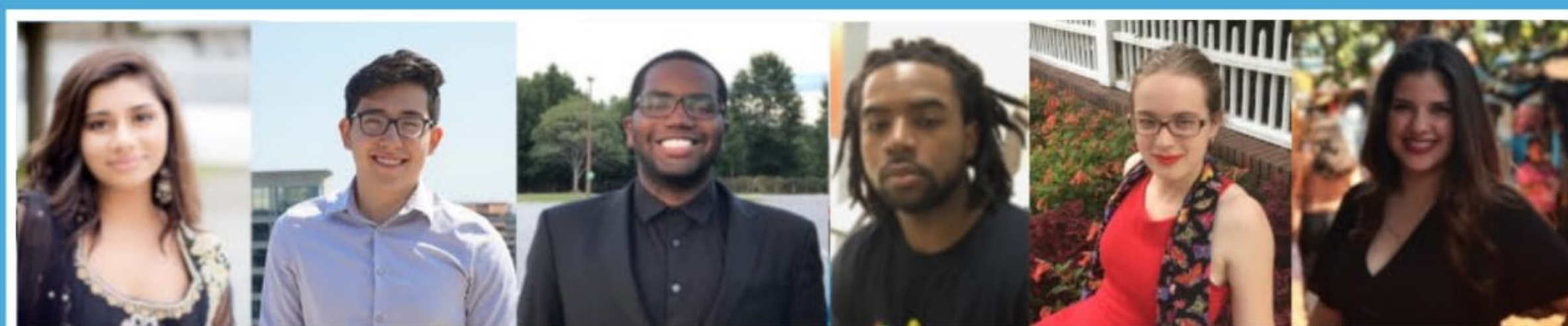
To the FGLI community at Yale,
